2009/2010 SASKENERGY GRASSROOTS SEMINARS

GRANT INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

The Skate Canada Saskatchewan and the Skater Development Committee is offering a grant of up to \$300.00 to affiliated Skate Canada clubs to host a SaskEnergy Grassroots seminar. **The number of grants is limited and must be applied for by Monday November 30th, 2009.** A Grassroots seminar may be any type of seminar that a club feels will benefit its members both on and/or off the ice. The seminar should provide a learning opportunity as well as generate a positive and enthusiastic activity for the club. It should be designed with a balance of fun and education. The Skater Development Committee has a standard one-day seminar, which touches on all parts of figure skating and may be used by a club. However, a club may feel its needs are to focus on free skate, skating skills, stroking, presentation or synchronized skating. A club may also feel it needs to have a seminar in dance and/or partnering. If possible, the host club should invite skaters and coaches from their region to attend the seminar. Seminars can also be 1/2 days in length. **All Seminars must be completed by March 1st, 2010 unless special permission is given through the Skater Development Office to have a Seminar in March. As well if your club would like to host a Seminar before November 30th please contact the Skater Development Office regarding your grant application.**

In deciding if your club would like to host a Grassroots Seminar, it is suggested to consult with your club coach and skaters. If there is a need in your club and you feel you would like a seminar, please fill in the attached Grant Application. The Skater Development Office will be available to assist your club in hiring seminar conductors, organizing a schedule for the seminar, and providing manuals if needed and generally helping with other administrative concerns such as the seminar budget.

In applying to host a seminar, a club should consider the following:

Responsibility to SaskEnergy and Skate Canada – Saskatchewan: Host clubs must use SaskEnergy in all publications involving the seminars and must post a SaskEnergy poster during the seminar. Skate Canada – Saskatchewan will provide the poster. The host club must also take pictures during the seminar and submit them with the follow-up report. The follow-up report must also have copies of all the publicity used to promote and report on the SaskEnergy seminar.

What type of seminar - one day, 1/2 day, freeskate, skating skills, presentation, precision, dance, partnering or combination, synchro

Who should attend - local skaters, skaters from region, ages of skaters, level of skating ability, parents

Who should conduct seminar - local coaches, coaches supplied by Skater Development, other coaches in region, out of province

Where it should be held & number of hours - on-ice sessions & off-ice sessions, classrooms

When it should be held - beginning of season, before test days, end of season, Saturday or Sunday - Are the times convenient?

How will it all work - advertisement, materials (manuals as well as overheads & VCR - generally depends on seminar & coach delivering seminar. Will you provide lunch as well as volunteers needed, music equipment, participation fee for those attending, etc.

A club should also have a tentative budget in place when applying for this grant and a form is attached to help with this process. The Program Developer, Dale Hazell of Skate Canada – Saskatchewan will be available to assist your club in any way possible if necessary. Hopefully you will use this opportunity to benefit your club. Remember the deadline date for the seminar application is **MONDAY NOVEMBER 30th, 2009.** If your club is selected to host a Grassroots Seminar the grant will be issued once the Skater Development Office receives a follow-up report one week following completion of the seminar. Notification of your acceptance will be by December 8th, 2009. A follow-up report form will be sent with notification.
