The Committee invites interested members to submit their resumes detailing the following information: **(Be assured that all information and your submission of interest will remain confidential.)**

1. Skating background/and or interest
2. Experience at committee level
3. Areas of interest within Skate Canada – Saskatchewan (i.e. Fundraising, Marketing, etc)
4. Skills you can bring to the board table
5. Time commitment available for a position on the board (approx 6 meetings / year held on Friday evening & Saturday morning)
6. \*\*When are you available to move from your club involvement to the section level i.e. this year, next year, 3 years from now, etc?

**From this information, the Committee will be able to plan for the future needs of the organization.**

- Team Work
- Good Interpersonal Skills

- Leadership Skills
