### NCCP Level 1 Technical Phase 3 Course

All skaters who are 16 years of age or older, have completed the Phase 2 Home Study and have passed three Junior Bronze skating tests are invited to attend. **The following will be covered in the course:** STARSkate Program, Preliminary & Junior Bronze skating skills, free skate and dance (performance standards), rules, skill analysis, interpretive skating, pair skating, synchronized skating, music & choreography, ethics, HR management, physical preparation, talent id, interviews, mentoring session, practice teaching, review/follow-up of home study, written test and on-ice lesson evaluation. **Applicants must be Skate Canada coaching members.**

Please complete and return the attached application and materials if your wish to attend. Numbers are limited. Applications will be accepted on a first come – first served basis.**

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

**There is no time limit to take the Phase 3 course after completing Phase 1 however, after September 1, 2009; a CanSkate Coach must become certified as a Canskate Coach if the Phase 3 is not completed after two years of consecutively coaching Canskate . This is a new rule recently established by Skate Canada. Information regarding this change and the Canskate certification process will be sent out as well as posted on the Skate Canada Saskatchewan web site once everything has been finalized.**

Coaches at the Phase 3 will participate in an on-ice lesson evaluation in which they will be assessed by a mentor coach or the Phase 3 Course Conductor. **After completing the Level 1 – Phase 3 course, coaches may begin teaching all Skate Canada programs provided they continue to register with Skate Canada as a coaching member. Once a coach has completed the Level 1 Phase 3 they have up to two years to complete the Level 1 Phase 4.** If this time limit can not be met, an extension can be granted. The Saskatchewan Coaching Department can only grant extensions. Information on the certification process will be discussed at the Level 1 Phase 3 course.
