Canadian Post-Secondary Students Grant Information and Application

For Registered Skate Canada Competitive Skaters

Skate Canada - Saskatchewan is offering two (2) grants to help support registered competitive skaters that continue to compete in the sport while at the same time furthering their education. Each grant is for \$500.00 and is available to competitive skaters who have attended a Canadian Post-Secondary Institute for at least one (1) year of studies.

- The recipient of this grant must be a full time student at a Canadian Post-Secondary institution and must submit a copy of their tuition fees and grade point average for the 2008/2009 school year (September 1/08 – June 30/09).
- The applicant must be a registered Skate Canada member for the 2008/2009 skating year.
- A written report outlining their involvement in the sport of figure skating must accompany the application.
- A letter of reference to support the application is a required.
- The recipient must be a competitive skater that competed at 2009 BMO Skate Canada Sectionals
- Applications without the required supporting documents will not be considered.

In the event that a large number of applications are received, priority will be given to applicants in upper year studies.

Deadline for application is **Tuesday, September 8th, 2009 - (Must be in office on this date)**. The successful applicant will be notified in early October.
