Skate Canada - Saskatchewan, in line with the sporting community, has implemented a policy to ensure the safety of our athletes. This policy requires that our team leaders and designated coaches to declare any criminal record that they may have. In accordance with this policy all prospective team leaders and designated coaches must have the declaration completed by a Police Force. When completed it is the team leaders or designated coaches' choice whether the form is turned in to the Skate Canada - Saskatchewan or not. This is a requirement however, and non-submission will disqualify you from a team leader or designated coach position with our organization. **Skate Canada – Saskatchewan** will not be made aware of any record you may have without your permission. A criminal record does not necessarily disqualify you from the position.

Please take the declaration to a Police Service in your community and ask that it be completed. Some Police Forces charge a fee for this check. You will also have to produce adequate identification. You may then examine the declaration and if you wish to pursue a team leader or designated coaching position, turn it in to the **Skate Canada - Saskatchewan** office along with your application.
