Policy Re: Canada Winter Games Team Selection

Team selection for the Canada Winter Games will be based on the following criteria:

- A registered member of Skate Canada
- A member of Team Saskatchewan in good standing
- Scores from summer competitions, Sectionals and Challenge
- An athlete's permanent domicile or actual residence must be located, for at least the 180 days prior to the opening of the Games, within the recognized boundaries of the Province or Territory they are representing. An athlete can have only one domicile. If training out-of-province, refer to Canada Winter Games Competitor Eligibility.
- Skate Canada Rule 5401* (Eligibility to compete) applies to all competitors, with the exception of 5401(3)*. For the Canada Games, competitors need to be Canadian Citizens or permanent residents, with no minimum residency requirement for permanent residents. *Rule numbers current as of July 1, 2016.
- Competitors must compete in the same category that they registered in at qualifying competition during the 2018-2019 competitive season
- A skater may enter one event only.
- Shall have passed the tests as listed in Skate Canada Qualifying Competition Handbook, regulation 510 before October 1st preceding the Games. A skater may also be considered qualified having passed a higher test or parts thereof as long as the minimum test requirement is fulfilled.
