- Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Canskate Festival Committee.
- Qualification for entry forms are as of Tuesday, January 17th, 2012.

Entry Fees

- \$10 for the first individual event and \$6 for any additional events. Team events shall be \$12 per team entered.
- All cheques are payable to **K. D. C. S. C.** and must accompany the registration forms.
- Postdated cheques will not be accepted.
- No refunds will be made without a medical certificate.
- If you require additional entry forms, please photocopy the necessary amount and distribute to your skaters.
- Final schedule of events will be mailed, emailed or telephoned to the skaters or the Club Representative after the closing date of entries.
- Entries may be limited and will be decided on a first come basis.
- All competition events will be held at the **Kincaid & District Community Rink.**

Registration

- Registration will be held in the lobby of the Kincaid & District Community Rink, beginning at 10am on Sunday, February 12, 2012.
- Skaters must register at least 1 hour prior to their first event.
- There will be no registration or gate entry fee for coaches with skaters.

System of Marking

CanSkate Fun Festival will not be judged. All participants will receive a report card.

Important Notices

- All skaters must be registered with Skate Canada.
- Skaters should be at the rink one hour prior to the start of each event and be ready 15 minutes before the event.
- In CanSkate events, boys and girls may compete against each other.

- Only clubs using the CanSkate program will be allowed to place entries in the events at the CanSkate level.
- The order of the events will be at the discretion of the CanSkate Festival Committee.
- The order of skaters will be posted before the start of the event.
- Only coaches and Festival officials allowed on the ice.

Admission

There will be an admission charge of \$3 per adult at the door. Programs will be available at the door.

CanSkate Fun Festival Events

Skaters registered in the CanSkate Festival Events will receive an evaluation for each event they have entered.

1. CanSkate Spin, Spiral & Jump Event

Open to all skaters in the CanSkate Program. All entrants - 45 second (music provided by the host club) to perform their own compulsory movements program containing an opening and closing movement, choice of spin, spiral (any variation) and jump in any order connected by connecting steps or other comparable free skating movements. 1/2 of the ice surface will be used. For this event, flights will be divided according to age and stage passed, as much as possible.

2. CanSkate Elements Program

In each event, except Stage 7, skaters will perform all three (3) selected elements in the following manner: There must be an opening and closing movement, 1/3 of the ice will be used, maximum time allowed per element program is 45 seconds, and there will be no music. Boys and girls will perform in the same flights. Skating dress is optional. In the Stage 7 event, the skater will perform all four (4) elements.

Qualifications: Skater **must not have passed more** than three (3) complete fundamentals of each stage.

- Stage 7:**
1. Forward chasses
 2. Backward progressives
 3. Sit Spin (one revolution)
 4. Waltz Jump (from backward crosscuts)

- Stage 6:**
1. Backward crosscuts in a figure 8 pattern
 2. Forward two-foot side stop with speed
 3. Turning on a curve forward to backward changing feet

- Stage 5:**
1. Forward crosscuts in a figure 8 pattern
 2. 1-foot side stop
 3. Forward power jump

- Stage 4:**
1. Backward glide on curve (two feet to one foot) either clockwise or counterclockwise
 2. Two (2) foot jump forward to backward and backward to forward on a curve
 3. Forward one foot spin (one revolution)

- Stage 3:**
1. Backward snowplow or backward 1/2 snowplow
 2. Two (2) foot spin picking up alternate feet
 3. Two-foot jump gliding backward

- Stage 2:**
1. Forward glide (2 feet to 1 foot)
 2. Forward snowplow or forward 1/2 snowplow
 3. Two-foot spin

- Stage 1:**
1. Walking around on the spot
 2. Walking backward (8 steps)
 3. Two-foot jump on the spot

3. CanSkate Team Events

Each team to be made up of four skaters, each skater to perform one element. When a team consists of three skaters, one skater would then perform two elements. When a team consists of two skaters, each will perform two elements.

Stage 2: Skaters must not have passed more than 3 complete fundamentals of the Stage 2 badge.

- Elements:**
1. Walking backward with glide
 2. Two-foot jump on the spot
 3. Two-foot 1/2 turn on the spot
 4. Forward 1/2 sit glide

Stage 3: Skaters must not have passed more than 3 complete fundamentals of the Stage 3 badge.

- Elements:**
1. Backward 2-foot sculling
 2. Forward snowplow or forward 1/2 snowplow
 3. 2-foot turn forward to backward
 4. 2-foot spin picking up alternate feet

Stage 4: Skaters must not have passed more than 3 complete fundamentals of the Stage 4 badge.

- Elements:**
1. 2-foot jump backward to forward on a curve
 2. Forward glide on a curve, 2 feet to 1 foot
 3. Forward one-foot spin (1 revolution)
 4. Backward 2-foot sculling

Stage 5: Skaters must not have passed more than 3 complete fundamentals of the Stage 5 badge.

- Elements:**
1. Forward circle thrusts, counterclockwise
 2. Turning on a curve (backward to forward). Changing feet, either inside or outside
 3. One-foot back spin (one revolution)
 4. Forward 2-foot side stop

Stage 6: Skaters must not have passed more than 3 complete fundamentals of the Stage 6 badge.

- Elements:**
1. Circle stroking with crosscuts and turns
 2. Turning on a curve - forward to backward - changing feet
 3. Backward circle thrusts (counterclockwise)
 4. One-foot spin with forward outside spiraling edged entry (minimum one revolution)

Stage 7: Skaters must not have passed more than 3 complete fundamentals of the Stage 7 badge.

- Elements:**
1. Backward progressives
 2. Sit spin (one revolution)
 3. Toe loop
 4. Forward two-foot side stop with speed
