



The 2010 Skate Canada Achievement Awards Skate Canada Officials Award of Excellence

This award will be presented to one individual at the Skate Canada Achievement Awards Gala. Active officials (judges, referees, technical controllers, technical specialists and data specialists) are eligible. Nominations should be sent to the Section by event technical representatives, chief data specialists, domestic or international event referees, National Team coaches, national or international Team Managers or any member of the Skate Canada Board of Directors and/or Section Board of Directors. The Section should then forward all the nomination forms to the National Office. Skate Canada reserves the right to not present this award in any given year.

Criteria:

- An active official who is currently registered with Skate Canada;
- Officiated at a minimum of one national* (or international) event in the 2009-2010 season;
- Demonstrated knowledge of, and is articulate regarding, Skate Canada programs and philosophies;
- An official who is keen to share accurate information with other officials, athletes, coaches, parents and administrators with the interest/intent of developing figure skating and figure skaters in Canada; and
- An individual who has given, and will continue to provide, quality service at the Section, National and/or International level.

*National events include BMO Skate Canada Challenges, BMO Skate Canada Junior Nationals, BMO Canadian Figure Skating Championships, BMO Skate Canada Synchronized Championships, Regional Festival of Synchronized Skating and the.

The Skate Canada President, Chairs of the Officials Coordinating Committee, Technical Officials Committee, and Officials Programs Manager, under the direction of Elite Athlete Director, Skate Canada will select the winner.
