



## 2012 PharmaChoice ROAD SHOW ANNOUNCEMENT !!

**The Skater Development Committee of Skate Canada - Saskatchewan is now accepting BIDS to HOST a 2012 PharmaChoice Road Show.**

The objective of a Skate Canada Saskatchewan Road Show is to promote the benefits of the sport of figure skating to members of a Saskatchewan club, their community and the surrounding area. Activities organized for a Road Show are meant to be motivational to the existing members and encouraging for future club members from the community and surrounding area. Some of the activities are as follows:

- High Performance Team members along with local skaters perform in the "SASKATCHEWAN STARS ON ICE" ice show in the local Community arena. Local skaters involvement may include performing solos, duets or group numbers. They will also do a group number with the Provincial team which is lots of fun and very easy to learn.
- Program Developer, Dale Hazell, conducts a group lesson with local Skate Canada skaters at the STARSkate level and those performing in the ice show
- High Performance Team members conduct a forty-five minute CanSkate session with local skaters
- A Skate Canada - Saskatchewan Executive is present to discuss all the Skate Canada programs to local and surrounding club executives if requested.
- Materials relating to the Skate Canada programs, T-shirts and other souvenirs are handed-out.

The High Performance Team and Saskatchewan Executive would like to come to your community. Executives should check with their members and coaches to see if this event would work in their club and community. The available dates for the Road Show are listed below. The Road Show takes approximately 5 hours and can be run during the day or in the evening. A complete schedule and a list of activities can be obtained from the Skater Development office. To help with organizing the travel arrangements for the Road shows please indicate on the application an alternate date if possible. If clubs chose the Monday or Tuesday, High Performance Team members will also make presentations at the local schools and be available to meet local media and business interests.

**COST TO CLUBS:** Clubs must be able to supply five hours of ice-time and a small lunch before the "Ice Show". \*Most clubs try to use ice on their regular day of skating. Billeting for approximately 24 High Performance team members will be needed on the Sunday & Monday nights. Clubs are also responsible for printing a local program for the Ice Show.

**PROMOTION:** This along with other duties will be explained once your application has been accepted. The Skater Development Committee does the majority of the planning and provides posters, music players and the announcer.

*A Road Show is a great way to finish a skating season especially for small clubs that no longer have ice shows. It is also a great opportunity to promote figure skating in your community. All of Saskatchewan's top skaters are part of the High Performance Team and will be participating. Clubs who have had the Road Show say it is extremely motivational for their skaters. **To help cover the cost of the Road Shows, Skate Canada - Saskatchewan keeps the admission fees from the "Ice Show".
